# Unison frustrated by disappointing pay award

The 0.5% pay increase was implemented last month. From Unison's perspective this was a very disappointing settlement – particularly as (at the time of writing) the rate of inflation is 2.9%. In plain English this means that your day to day living costs are increasing more than the pay rise you have been awarded, leaving you worse off! Unison's national negotiators accepted the pay offer through gritted teeth - and are sending a clear message to the employers that they will strongly oppose a similar poor offer for next year.

#### Overtime / TOIL / Flexi review to be undertaken

HR are about to undertake a review of the flexi-time, overtime and time-off in lieu systems. The aim is to harmonise how overtime is worked across staff groups at the University. Your Unison Rep's will be responsible for representing your voice before any agreement is reached – so we need to know your views and concerns about this issue.

### Restructures, Redundancies, Re-gradings – The impact of the University's Financial Resilience Programme

The University is continuing with its Financial Resilience Programme and several more departments are undergoing restructure, with staff ending up either redundant or in lower graded jobs.

Unison is there at each stage of the process demanding transparency and accountability. We are also supporting staff that face redundancy to help them understand their options and ensure they get the best possible outcome in a difficult situation. Staff Development are also offering intensive support to staff at risk of redundancy and, following a request from Unison, HR have put in place guidance to manage the negative impact of redundancies on those remaining in post.
