
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Skills for Work Apprenticeships

Skills for Work deliver the following Apprenticeships:

- Business Admin Level 3
- Customer Service Levels 2 and 3
- Public Service Operational Delivery Officer Level 3
- Team Leader Levels 3
- Management Levels 4 and 5
- Coaching and Mentoring Levels 3 and 5
- HR Support Level 3 (from August 2024)



The Duration is between 15 and 30 months depending on the level of the apprenticeship. Apprenticeships can be delivered to existing members of staff and new recruits. Apprenticeships are work-based training schemes that are designed to help you foster emerging talent in your business. They combine work with study and result in a programme which is truly work focused.

Skills for Work deliver workshops at Chapel Street to support learners to achieve their apprenticeship. You will be made aware of any release dates at the beginning of the apprenticeship and this will be included in the individual training plan.

The tutor will also visit the learner within the workplace to help and support them with their apprenticeship. By creating new solutions to deliver apprenticeships online, Skills for Work is helping to increase accessibility, flexibility and convenience for both the employer and the employee. We have moved to a more online presence, delivering sign ups, inductions and workshops via online delivery platforms when required.

Community Learning & Adult Skills Service (CLASS)

Our courses can be delivered in a variety of locations such as in our Centre, Schools, Libraries and Community Venues. We are also deliver short online courses. Our courses are developed and delivered based on the priorities of the community and the needs of the individual learners.

The Community Learning Service delivers a wide range of non-accredited community learning courses to support individuals and families across the Bradford district. We deliver a range of accredited qualifications from Entry Level to Level 2.

Our courses available include:

Functional Skills, English and Maths up to Level 2, ESOL, ICT/Digital Skills from Entry Level to Level 2, Numeracy, "Multiply," courses for those not confident with maths or would like with budgeting, Teaching Assistant level 2 and 3 and a range of qualifications from preentry level.
