



“Stop avoiding linking Moodle content with seminar content”

“Stop using a mass amount of links to various word documents, as it blocks and clutters the page making access to Moodle resources awkward to find. Instead put all links in one headed file”

“I would like for raw text to be stopped posting on Moodle (Not in a .txt file)”

“Instead of having every week open, minimise them and be able to open the week that you want and make it more descriptive”

“Stop having mandatory SOL tasks on Moodle” [there are too many between classes]

“[One of my modules] really lacks depth and aid for students, to the extent that the assessment questions were not even uploaded and I had to personally email the head of department”

“Start including more content and make people more aware of alternative/unusual functions of Moodle (activities and resources)”

“I would like more interactive content! (Quizzes)”

“To release info for each week at the start of the semester so you have the chance to read ahead and stay on top of your work. Utilise the different resources on Moodle such as Quiz and Chat”

“Start having summaries of lectures/seminars on Moodle, continue providing links to free articles and e books”

“Module list to be set out in order of semester so more easily accessible”

“Would be good if all lecturers set up module page so there is a week by week plan including reading and the subject of the letter so students can be more organized”

“Start uploading brief weekly descriptions of what is going to be included within that particular week”

“In product design, we don’t really use Moodle as quite a lot of our work is paper work (non electrical) but this year our head of art and design is leading the special study module and uses Moodle a lot and is how everything is given to us, including submission of work... It would be better if all staff used Moodle as it is better than a hand out or starting using Moodle then stopping it halfway through the semester”

“One of our modules has very little sources and Moodle is rarely used”

“Make more of an effort to have ALL timetables completed in time for beginning of classes”

“Start communicating with YSJ timetable to align the YSJ timetable with the Module timetable”

“It would be nice to be able to have access to a timetable via moodle for each semester, as the YSJ timetable is cluttered and confusing”

“I'd like to see more standardisation for lecture/seminar notes, as if I'm unable to attend it's hard to catch up without arranging an appointment with the lecturer”
